



Allan Robert Petker is a composer and arranger with more than 250 published works at numerous publishing houses. He maintains a lively commission schedule for compositions, ranging from anthems for choir to large scale works with orchestra. His conducting books, "Choral Questions and Answers," have become staples in school curriculum and for secondary resource material.

Allan has been involved in the choral music publishing industry for many years. In 1977 he joined the staff at Fred Bock Music Company and subsidiaries, and is now their Vice President of Publications. In 1989 he established his own company, Pavane Publishing, which is known for its quality publications for church and school, as well as its textbooks and resource materials. He later added John Rich

Music Press, the lighter voice of Pavane Publishing, to his portfolio.

As a conductor, Allan is in frequent demand as a guest clinician for publishers, choral societies, church festivals, state honor choirs and colleges. He has led choral workshops and guest conducted in England and South Korea, and most recently in southern France. In the summer of 1994 he formed the *Consort Chorale*, an ensemble of 45 select voices from the San Francisco Bay area, which maintains an on-going concert series. In 2004 he became the Conductor and Artistic Director for the *Santa Clarita Master Chorale*, a 70-voice auditioned their in the Los Angeles area. The two chorales combined for a concert tour in Pastern Europe in 2008 and again in 2011, and head to Russia in 2014. He is currently the Minister of Music at the First Presbyterian Church in San Pedro, California.

Allan is a past President of the National As a citator of Church Musicians and also serves as the dean of two church music conference. each summer at Lake Tahoe, "Summer Sing" and "Tuning @ Tahoe."
