
Autumn Gives Her Hand to Winter - P1726 Keith Loftis HL# 1188364 \$2.95 SATB, Piano


Be in Love - JR1141 William V. Malpede HL# 1189838 \$2.95 SATB, Piano Sr. HS College Community





There has recently been a resurgence of interest in his work, as the world awakens to classical composers outside of Western Europe. This delightful setting of the Liturgical Latin from the Mass is an excellent choice for both church and school choirs. Orchestral score and parts available separately.









Cook effortlessly maintains a hymn-like style infused with fluidity, freedom, just the right touch of dissonance, and a final cadence that brings a smile to the soul.

The piece was notably performed by Tonality, an ensemble conducted by self-proclaimed music activist Alexander Lloyd Blake. Their award-winning rendition brought renewed attention to the piece's inclusive message and compiling musical setting.

Drawing his text from Mahatma Gandhi and Rumi, Malpede transports an ageless message to the 21st century. The lesson of acceptance, love, and peace could not be more transparently simple, but the melody and harmony are captivating.
